- SKUAST-Jammu is conducting the Computer Based Type Test and Short Hand Test (Dictation and Transcription) of the candidates for the post of Stenographers advertised vide Notification No 09 (Secy.) of 2023 dated: 19.07.2023, at National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT), University of Jammu on 23rd January and 24th January, 2024.

- Admit Cards for the candidates, whose Type Test and Shorthand test (Dictation and Transcription) is scheduled on the aforesaid dates shall be hosted on SKUAST-Jammu website (www.skuast.org) from 17th of January, 2024 (after 04:00 PM).
- 4. The qualifying criteria and duration of the Type Test and Short Hand Test (Dictation and Shorthand) for the post of the Stenographers is as under:

Stenographers (Dictation, Transcriptions and Type Test)	Type Test : Typing speed of 30 words per minute	10 minutes (300 words)	5% of the total words typed are ignored i.e. 95% accuracy	23 rd & 24 th of January, 2024
	Dictation : A paragraph of 250 words will be dictated (shorthand speed of 50 words per minute)	5 Minutes (250 words)	8% mistakes allowed (20 mistakes for 250 words)	
	Transcription	15 minutes	L V	

- 5. All those candidates who qualify the Type Test as per the above said criteria shall only be allowed to appear in Stenography Test (Dictation, Transcription of the Dictation) which shall be held in batches on the same date & venue after the Type Test of the Candidate.
- 6. The aforesaid Type Test and Stenography Test is of qualifying in nature only. All those candidates who qualify both the Type Test and Stenography Test shall be called for appearing in the Written Test, the dates for which shall be notified separately by the University. The final selection to the above said post shall be purely based on the merit of the Written Test.
