	The overall selection procedure shall incorporate transparent, objective and credible methodology of analysis of the merits and credentials of the applicants based on the weightage given to the performance of the candidate in different relevant parameters and his/her performance on a grading system proforma, based on Appendix : I (Assistant Professor/ Junior Scientist/SMS) and Appendix : II, (Associate Professor/ Senior Scientist and Above)
	In order to make the system more credible, the University may assess the ability for teaching and /or research and/or extension aptitude through a seminar or lecture in a classroom situation or discussion on the capacity to use the latest technology in teaching and research at the interview stage. These procedures can be followed for both the direct recruitment and the CAS promotions, wherever selection committees are prescribed.

	<i>Provided</i> that the publications submitted by the candidate shall have been published during the qualifying period.
	<i>Provided</i> further that such publications shall be made available to the subject experts for assessment before holding the interview. The evaluation of the publications by the experts shall be taken into consideration while finalizing the outcome of selection.
	Counting of Past Services for Direct Recruitment
