Activity 1

The occasion was not only graced by the experts of national eminence but they also interacted with the students on their innovative ideas that were exhibited by them on traditional Jammu region cuisine and conventional agriculture implements which includes eight food items (Nishasta, Madra, Auria, Kyur, Charoli, Timbru ki Chutney, Bathrode, Pallae) and seven conventional agriculture tools/cultural items (Sagla/Deshka, Plaetra, Gudnu, Sanghi, Triongle, Peeda, Tungi).

- Padma Shri, Dr. Rajani Kant, National IP Awardee, in his address he informed that there is probability of GI tagging of nine products of Jammu and Kashmir by March 2023.
- Padma Shri, Dr. VP Singh, Former Head, Division of Genetics, ICAR-IARI, threw light on the development of different varieties of Basmati

The objective of the workshop to sensitise all stakeholders on GIs, the oldest category of trademarks, identify potential products & formulate future strategy to empower rural communities. 30 UG students from SKUAST Jammu participated in the workshop. The students came to know about how to establish local brands in the global market through effective brand & marketing strategy and mechanisms that is being evolved to address the challenges faced by producer and how GIs play a key role in protection of indigenous knowledge.


