SKUAST TEACHERS, STUDENTS CONDEMN NIT SRINAGAR INCIDENT, SEEK PROBE

Jammu, April 7: SKUAST - Teaching Association Jammu (SKUAST-TAJ) and students strongly condemned the incident of attacks on non-Kashmiri NIT students and brutal lathi charge on the them by J&K police and demanded that a new government should ensure the safety and security of students at any cost.

In a press statement, SKUAST-TAJ President, Dr. Vikas Sharma alleged that government has failed to ensure the safety of non-local students and its repercussions can have dangerous ramifications. He described it as a conspiracy to create wedge in the society and warned such elements not to play with the future of nation. Dr. Vivek M Arya, General Secretary said that after Hydrabad and JNU-Delhi this unfortunate incident has taken place in our State as some people were playing dirty politics in the educational institutions and he demanded a time bound probe into the whole matter by the sitting High Court judge. In addition, UG and PG students of SKUAST Jammu protested against the incident and questioned the entry of police inside the campus and classrooms of NIT. Agitating Student leaders Mr. Divyansh Verma, Gurminder Singh and others demanded suspension of police officers present at that time and permanent CRPF deployment in the wake of situation at NIT.
